Pope Benedict XV approved a new title for Our Lady in May 1921, impressed by the rapid development of the Oratory of St Francis de Sales since 1913 and the welcome given to World War One refugees. He indicated the shrine's status as a Major Marian Shrine by attaching a Plenary Indulgence.
