

But did you know that...

Apart from the Offertory income, we also need to collect separate funds for repairs to the thatch and roof.

- Cover day-to-day running costs.
- Pay for building costs & repairs.
- > Support Parish Programmes and Projects.
- We are a Member of a Diocese, we pay towards it and assist it
- Save a % of our income for emergency repairs & future projects



Our Church and Parish Buildings are in need of regular repairs and maintenance and therefore we need your Constant support. In the future we wish to invest in the spiritual life of our Parish by starting projects and initiatives for young people and religious instruction for lay people and the younger generation.

There are many ways to contribute financially by contributing to the Offertory Collection, Donating Online – You can even set up a Monthly Contribution online, Pledge, Standing Orders and signing up to Gift Aid

Gift Aid is easy to do, doesn't cost you a penny and helps our Parish!



If you are a UK tax payer please consider signing up to Gift Aid – the Parish can claim 25% extra on every pound you donate.

- 87% of donations were Gift Aided in 2021
- Last year, 60 out of 220 parishioners (Ave. Weekend Mass Count before Covid) Gift Aided. NB: Ave. Weekend Mass Count after Covid is 86.
- If more people signed up to Gift Aid, we could receive extra money each year back from HMRC.

Standing Order is one of the best ways to support our Parish!

A standing Order is an instruction to your bank to make regular fixed payments to our Parish. This provides secure, regular income that is easy to Gift Aid, easy to reconcile and takes less time than counting loose change each week. You do not need to worry about getting cash each week for Mass. Set up/amend your Standing Order next week you need your bank account number / sort code.



The percentage is out of our total Gift Aid donors which was approximately 60 going into 2022
