RE: Fr Patrick moving on

After 20 years in a parish, the priest was moved. His parishioners threatened to riot should the Bishop stick with the decision. To pacify them, the priest told them that the Bishop has promised to send them a better priest. But he learnt the lesson of his life when they promptly told him: "Father, we can't trust the Bishop; that was the same promise he made when he moved the priest before you."

Beloved parishioners, the Book of Ecclesiastes (3:1-8) tells us that there is time for everything under the sun. I'm very sorry to inform you that it is the opportune time now for your Parish Priest Fr Patrick Adusei Poku to move on. During my pastoral visit to you last February, I could discern how, together, you have rekindled the flame of the faith in your community. It will therefore feel inappropriate to move Fr Patrick now. The irony, however, is that the reward for good work is more work (not a good holiday in Hawaii). Fr Patrick is therefore being called to greater responsibility in a much more demanding mission. We urgently need Fr Patrick's experience and talents for this new mission.

Fr Patrick has been appointed to be the parish priest of Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church Acton & St Aidan East Acton in West London, Westminster Diocese. Fr Patrick would be assisted by another Spiritan priest. The parish was run by three priests from the Sacred Heart Religious Order.

I would love to thank you immensely for welcoming Fr Patrick and the massive support he has enjoyed serving you these couple of years.

Note however, that the ultimate measure of his success in his time with you will be determined by how easily his successor settles into the role. That would demonstrate that it hadn't just been about the individual but about bequeathing a robust Christian Community. You all therefore have a role to play in ensuring that your new Parish Priest, Fr Alphonsus Beni CSSp, feels welcome to serve you.

Both will resume in their new roles on the 1_# of September. Transitions will therefore commence from about the second half of August. I thank you once again for the great experience we, the Spiritans, have shared with you in Fr Patrick. May this grow even more with Fr Alphonsus for the good of the mission and to the greater glory of God. Amen. Yours in mission and service,
