## WE WELCOME FR ALPHONSUS BENI, CSSP

Fr Alphonsus Beni, CSSp is a Ghanaian by birth. He joined the Spiritan Congregation in 1995 in Kumasi after haven taught as a professional teacher with the Ghana Education Service for two years. He took his first vows in Ejisu, Ghana on the 8th of September, 1997 and continue with his philosophical studies also in Ejisu, Ghana. He did his pastoral experience in Sierra Leone from 2000 to 2001. In August 2001 he was enrolled in the Spiritan Formation Community in Langata, Nairobi, Kenya for his theological studies in Tangaza College, now Tangaza University. He took his final vows on the 28th of August, 2004 and was ordained a Deacon the next day. On the 16th of July, 2005 he was ordained priest in Wa Cathedral, Ghana.

He worked as an assistant priest in the Archdiocese of Kumasi for one year before moving to the Diocese of Navrongo – Bolgatanga for another one year after which he was appointed Postulant and Vocations Director for the Province of Ghana in 2008. In 2010, he was appointed Registrar and lecturer of the Spiritan University College and was later given an additional responsibility as the Vice Rector in 2014.

Fr Alphonsus has separate undergraduate degrees and diplomas in Philosophy, Religious Studies, Theology and a master's degree in Educational Administration. He has a PhD in geography and rural development from Kwame Nkrumah University of Science and Technology. His research interest is in developmental issues, poverty



reduction and Education. He has published articles in peer-reviewed International Journals on developmental related issues. His first book publication was on the 'Challenges of Financial Administration in Public Senior High Schools'. His second book publication was on 'The Effects of Formal Education on Poverty Reduction in Ghana'.

Fr Alphonsus was appointed to UK for his sabbaticals after 11 years in the Formation house and Spiritan University College community. His first appointment in the UK was in SS Michael & Martin Parish, Hounslow, London as assistant priest and from 01/09/2022 as Parish Priest in St Francis De Sales Parish, Hartley.
