There is significant work and activities been undertaken in the archdiocese supporting migrants and refugees. Earlier in 2023 the Catholic Bishops Conference of England and Wales published. 'Love the Stranger' A reflection on the Churches teaching on the welcome and support of refugees and migrant people as well as insight into the justice issues which inform migration. Some seminars are being piloted in two deaneries in the archdiocese and Caritas would like to offer these more widely.
