This will take effect from the First Sunday of Advent this year - 1st December 2024. Therefore our Sunday Mass books, along with any other books we use, will also expire soon, and we have now to place an order in time for the change over.

The upcoming costs will be as follows:

- 1. New Lectionary, 4 Volumes @ £175.00 per volume, total £695.00
- 2. New Book of the Gospels, £275.00
- 3. New Lectionary Study, £250.00

Pre-ordering and payment allows us a 15% discount of £183.00 on these books.
