This will take effect from the First Sunday of Advent this year - 1st December 2024. Therefore our Sunday Mass books, along with any other books we use, will also expire soon, and we have now to place an order in time for the change over.

The costs are as follows:

- 2. New Book of the Gospels, £275.00
- 3. New Lectionary Study, £250.00 Pre-ordering and payment allows us a 15% in our Archdiocese as well as we pray for the discount of £183.00 on these books.
