This will take effect from the First Sunday of Advent this year - 1st December 2024.

Therefore our Sunday Mass books, along with any other books we use, will also expire soon and we have now to place our order. The new Sunday Mass Books for Years A,B,C, with 2 volumes per year, cost £5.95 per copy — and are on offer at £5 per copy for preordering — allowing us a saving of £684.00.
