SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION FOR FIRST RECONCILATION AND HOLY COMMUNION.

For parents whose children are in school Year 3 or above, and who are seeking to enrol their children onto the Sacramental Program for Reconciliation & Eucharist, please ask the priest for an application form after Saturday/Sunday Masses, with your child attending. The closing date to return forms will be Monday 30th September. Parents will be contacted soon after the closing date with further details. Thank you.

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

For young people in Secondary School Yr8 or above who are interested in preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, application forms will be available from this weekend to pick up from the church. Please ask the priest for a form after attending Mass. The closing date to apply is Monday 7th October. If you submitted a form last year, you do not need to reapply. All parents will be contacted with further information in October. Thank you.

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults)

Are You Interested in Becoming a Catholic? If you have never been baptized, or if you were baptized in another Christian

denomination and would like to become Catholic, or if you were baptized Catholic but never received the Sacraments of Eucharist or Confirmation, you are welcome to join the RCIA program, the process by which people become Catholic. Please speak to Fr Clement to discuss further.
