Parents of children in school Year 3 or above, seeking to enrol their children onto the Sacramental Program for Reconciliation & Eucharist, please attend Mass with your child and ask the priest for an application form. The closing date to return forms will be Monday 30th September. Parents will be contacted after the closing date with further details. Thank you.

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

For parents of young people in School Yr8 or above who are interested in preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation, please attend Mass and ask the priest for an application form. The closing date to apply is Monday 7th October. If you submitted a form last year, you do not need to reapply. All parents will be contacted with further information later in October. Thank you.

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults)

Are You Interested in Becoming a Catholic? If you have never been baptized, or if you were baptized in another Christian denomination and would like to become Catholic, or if you were baptized Catholic but never received the Sacraments of Eucharist or Confirmation, you are welcome to join the RCIA program, the process by which people become Catholic.
