#### PARISH REGISTRATION

We welcome all new parishioners to St Francis de Sales, Hartley. We want you to feel at home in the parish. The first thing to do is to introduce yourself to Fr Clement and register on the Parish Database. Forms are available in the porch/on the parish website.

#### **CATECHETICAL PROGRAMMES**

Parishioners are asked to first check the SACRAMENTS section on the parish website for general information, then speak with Fr Clement for any further advice. Those wishing to enrol for Sacramental programs should be registered parishioners.

#### **BAPTISM FOR BABIES AND INFANTS**

Parents of infants and those seeking Baptism, please attend Sunday Mass and ask the priest for a Baptism Application form and Mass Attendance form. Thank you.

#### CHILDREN'S LITURGY: Resumes on Nov 10th

For children aged 4-7years on Sunday during 10.15am Mass. Please bring your child into the Mass for blessing before going with leaders to the Meeting Room. Please speak to Fr Clement if you would like to help.

### SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION FOR FIRST RECONCILATION AND HOLY COMMUNION.

For children who have been accepted onto the program, the first lesson will be on Monday 11th November in the church meeting room at 3:30pm-4:30pm.

#### **SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION**

Parents who submitted an application form have been contacted with further details. If you have not submitted a form for your child, please speak to Fr Clement after attending Mass with your child. Thank you.

### **RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults)**

Are You Interested in Becoming a Catholic? If you have never been baptized, or if you were baptized in another Christian denomination and would like to become Catholic, or if you were baptized Catholic but never received the Sacraments of Eucharist or Confirmation, you are welcome to join the RCIA program, the process by which people become Catholic. Please speak to Fr Clement for further help.

#### PERMANENT DIACONATE

If you are a man between 21 years to 58 years, prayerful, involved in services within your parish and community, and feel drawn to a closer relationship with Christ and His Church - you might possibly be called to be a Permanent Deacon? If you require further information about the Permanent Diaconate, speak to Fr. Clement.

#### MARRIAGE PREPARATION PROCESS

You are required to give 6 months notice of Marriage, whether it is taking place here or abroad. Couples wishing to be married, contact Fr. Clement as early as possible.

#### PARISH YOUTH GROUP-PLEASE REGISTER

Over 18's can fill in a registration form and return it to Fr Clement. For under 18's, parents must sign the form to give their

#### **NEW MASS BOOKS AND LECTIONARIES.**

Thank you to everyone who has so far sponsored our new Lectionaries, Book of Gospels, and Parish Mass Books that we will be using from 1st December 2024, the First Sunday of Advent, Year C.

The Parish Mass Books that are for the

parishioners/congregation to use come in 2

volumes (Vol 1 & Vol 2) for each year of the three year cycles A, B and C and we are ordering 120 copies of each book for each of the 6 volumes, as we have done before. We have so far received donations to buy 120 Mass Books for Year C Vol 1 and Year C Vol 2, and further donations for 120 Mass Books for Year A, Vol 1.
