ST. FRANCIS DE SALES FEAST DAY/THE CONVERSION OF ST. PAUL/THE ANNIVERYSARY OF THE FOUNDATION DAY OF THE CONGREGATION OF THE MISSION.

A brief history of the Congregation from its Constitutions and Statutes.

St. Vincent de Paul was born in the village of Pouy in 1581. As a boy he lived among the poor and experienced the conditions under which they lived. In 1600 he became a priest. For a time, he sought to escape from the poverty of his origins, but with the help of spiritual directors he felt himself called to deeper holiness and, through the events of his life, was finally led by divine providence to a firm determination to dedicate himself to the salvation of the poor. While he was exercising his ministry in Gannes and, on the 25th of January 1617, in Folleville, he saw that the evangelization of the poor was an urgent need. He himself held that this was the origin of his vocation, and of the Congregation of the Mission.

In 1617 Madame de Gondi asked Monsieur Vincent to preach in her properties on general confession. The Feast of The Conversion of Saint Paul, January 25th, was the opportunity to preach such a sermon in the village of Folleville in northern France. The response was incredible. In the next days, Vincent de Paul and his associates preached in nearby churches and crowds of peasant parishioners lined up for confessions. They even asked Jesus from Amiens to come and help them.

This first mission sermon, as he called it, St. Vincent regarded as the beginning of the Company of the Priests of the Mission. However, there was no formal institution founded until April 17, 1625, when the legal contract was signed to found the Congregation of the Mission.

These two dates, 1617 and 1625, are the principal milestones in the history of the Little Company, as St. Vincent used to call it. In 2025 we will celebrate the 400year anniversary of the foundation of the Congregation of the Mission. Preparations began last year. This year, we are moving to another step of the pre-celebration of the Jubilee, in which the theme is: "Put on the Spirit of Jesus Christ" AS PILGRIMS OF HOPE.

What is the relationship between St. Francis de Sales and Vincent de Paul?

In 1618 or 1619, Vincent de Paul met Francis de Sales in Paris. Vincent was profoundly influenced by Francis' writings especially An Introduction to the Devout Life, and Treatise on the Love of God, the spirituality of Francis de Sales. Vincent de Paul had him as his confessor.

What is 25th January to the Vincentians?

25th of January is the feast of the conversion of St. Paul. It is also the foundation day of the Congregation of the Mission (the Vincentians)

Providentially, the Congregation of the Mission (the Vincentians) arrived and are serving the parish of St. Francis de Sales, making it the double celebration of the parish feast day and foundation day.

I invite every parishioner to join in this celebration as we mark it as 'Pilgrims of hope'

To Celebrate our Parish Feast day and Foundation day, we will have one parish Mass on the weekend of Sunday 26th January at 10:00am. After the Mass, everyone is invited to gather as one community for brunch in Our Lady of Hartley school hall.
